

Maple Lake Chamber of Commerce, Inc
General Meeting Minutes
June 3, 2020

The noon meeting was called to order by President John Volden on June 3, 2020 at The "V". There were 11 businesses present.

Secretary's report: The March 4, 2020 minutes were read by Cathy Elfstrand. A motion by Paul Manuel and second by Nick Pawlenty to approve the March minutes. Because of Covid-19 "Stay at home" order, our April and May meetings had to be cancelled.

Treasurer's report: Kathy Hennen read the balances in the following accounts as follows: Chamber checking \$15,363.84, Gearhead checking \$9,185.98, Ambassador/Chamber checking \$2,623.80, Ambassador/Celebrate Maple Lake savings \$2,505.47, Lord Abbett investment \$27,441.11.

Government report: (received after the meeting from the City) Restaurants are able to apply for a temporary expansion of their Liquor License premise. Oak Ave will be closed until August. New playground equipment has been installed at the Community Park and ready to play on. Bolduan Park also received additional playground equipment. There will be a new Public Works employee joining the City. Kenny Elsenpeter from Public Works has officially retired, they hope to have a celebration for him soon. City Hall is now back open

Committee reports:

Irish Party: Linda Rassat reported we had 140 people in attendance. We had a net income of \$2,423.53. Advertising and the Entertainment costs were higher this year.

Celebrate Maple Lake: Tricia Manuel displayed the t-shirts and sweatshirts she has for sale at the Costume Shop with the proceeds going to the Chamber.

St. Patrick's Day Parade: Nick Pawlenty commented on how kind the people participating in the parade were when they cancelled the Event. The sponsorship money was kept because of all the advertising that was done and the dinners at the Irish Party that were included.

Gear-Head Get together: After the Board spoke with the Gear-Head committee and the cancellation of all the events in the State it was decided to cancel the Gear-Head event.

A motion was made by Kathy Hennen and second by Linda Rassat to adjourn the meeting.
