

Maple Lake Chamber of Commerce, Inc.

Meeting was called to order by President Scott Millner at noon on June 6, 2018 at the American Legion. Introductions were made. There were 14 businesses present.

Secretary's Report by Nick Pawlenty: A motion was made by John Volden and second by Linda Rassat to approve the minutes of the May 2, 2018 meeting. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report by Kathy Hennen: Balances in the following accounts were read as follows: General account \$15,891.57, Gear-Head account \$19,931.52, Lord Abbett Investment \$23,923.60, Ambassador checking \$1,818.77 and Ambassador Savings \$2,500.75. A motion to accept the Treasurer's report was made by Paul Manuel and second by John Volden. Motion carried.

Government Report by LeeAnn Yager: The council approved the construction plan and parking restrictions for the mini-roundabout at the intersections of Division, County Rd 8 and Elm Ave. A public hearing has been called for July 17th on a proposed TIF district for a new 12 unit apartment complex by the Dollar General. The chicken ordinance passed. Cost for a permit will be \$50.00 for up to 6 chickens with an annual renewal fee of \$25.00. Brewfest will be Saturday, June 16th from 2-5 p.m. at Irish Stadium.

Gear-head by Scott Chantland: The entertainment has been booked and committee chairs have been working hard to organize the event. Because of the State Baseball tournament which will be held next year in Irish Stadium the transfer of the event this year will begin to move to St. Timothy's parking lot and the City Park. The BMX show will be on Star Street.

Old Business: Members were able to view the sample proof for replacing the downtown banners. With the approval of the members present at the meeting, a motion was made by Paul Manuel and second by John Volden to accept the proofs.

New Business: Because of the July 4th Holiday, our noon meeting will be moved to the following Wednesday, July 11th at the Bethlehem UCC. Xcel energy will be updating the street light poles in town. The city will no longer be able to hang the Christmas lights from the poles. The Chamber board is working on different ways for the Chamber businesses to use our face book page for advertising.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Marilyn Groth and second by Paul Manuel to adjourn the meeting. The motion was approved unanimously.
